The Avenue Footways , <i>west side</i> , From 6m north of the northern kerblines of Northlands Road to the southern access road to The Cowherds public house	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue Verges , <i>west side</i> , From 6m north of the northern kerblines of Northlands Road northwards for 6m (diagonal access to main cycle route)	Pedal cycles only
Southern access road to The Cowherds public house , continuous footway across the access road at its junction with The Avenue.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue Footways , <i>west side</i> , From the northern kerblines of the southern access road to The Cowherds public house northwards for 49m	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue & The Avenue Verges , <i>west side</i> , From 44m north of the northern kerblines of the southern access road to The Cowherds public house northwards for 12m (diagonal access to cycle lane)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue Footways , <i>west side</i> , From 120m south of the extended southern kerblines of Highfield Road southwards for 27m (bus stop bypass)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue & The Avenue Footways , <i>west side</i> , From 155m north of the extended northern kerblines of Highfield Avenue northwards for 22m (bus stop bypass)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue Footways , <i>west side</i> , From 154m north of the extended northern kerblines of Highfield Avenue to the southern kerblines of Burgess Road	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue Footways , <i>east side</i> , From the southern kerblines of Burgess Road to the northern kerblines of Highfield Avenue	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
Highfield Avenue Footways , <i>north side</i> , From its junction with The Avenue Footways south-eastwards for 6m	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue Footways , <i>east side</i> , From 188m north of the northern kerblines of Highfield Road northwards for 18m (bus stop bypass)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue Verges , <i>east side</i> , From 72m south of the southern kerblines of Highfield Road southwards for 18m (bus stop bypass)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue Verges , <i>east side</i> , From 31m north of the northern kerblines of Winn Road northwards for 10m (diagonal connection to cycle lane)	Pedal cycles only
The Avenue Footways , <i>east side</i> , From the northern kerblines of Winn Road northwards for 35m	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
Winn Road , continuous footway across Winn Road at its junction with The Avenue	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
The Avenue Footways , <i>east side</i> , From southern kerblines of Winn Road southwards for 36m	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
New route on the eastern side of The Avenue, From 36m south of the southern kerblines of Winn Road to the northern kerblines of Westwood Road partially in place of the existing gravel path	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
Westwood Road , continuous footway across Westwood Road at its junction with The Avenue	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
