 - a From 13m south of the southern kerbline of the northern access road to the Cowherds public house to 147m south of the extended southern kerbline of Highfield Road,
 - **b** From 120m south of the extended southern kerbline of Highfield Road to 155m north of the extended northern kerbline of Highfield Road
- 2 To introduce the following mandatory with-flow cycle lanes in **The Avenue**, *East side*:
 - **a** East side, From 4m south of the southern kerbline of Highfield Avenue to 206m north of the northern kerbline of Highfield Road
 - **b** From 188m north the northern kerbline of Highfield Road to 72m south of the southern kerbline of Highfield Road
 - **c** From 90m south of the southern kerbline of Highfield Road to 41m north of the northern kerbline of Winn Road
